1. The harsh conditions of the winter seemed to untemper his usual optimism.
2. She tried to untemper her excitement, knowing the surprise had to remain a secret for a little longer.
3. The unexpected criticism served to untemper his confidence just before the presentation.
4. To untemper her anger, she took a few deep breaths and counted to ten.
5. His calm demeanor helped to untemper the heated debate among the group.
