

UNTRUSS

Meaning: Untruss: to remove the supports or fastenings from a structure or equipment, thereby lightening or dismantling it.

1. As the climber reached the summit, he decided to untruss his gear to lighten his load for the descent.
2. The engineer had to untruss the old scaffolding before beginning the renovation on the historic building.
3. After the storm, they needed to untruss the fallen branches from the power lines to restore electricity to the neighborhood.
4. To enhance the performance of the kite, she chose to untruss the strings and adjust the tension.
5. In the midst of the project, they realized they had to untruss the entire structure to assess the damage properly.
