Meaning: UNTURN (verb): To reverse or negate a decision, belief, or state, especially in the face of opposition or challenge.

1. The artist's vision was so strong that it could not be unturned by criticism.
2. Even after years of experience, he felt that the truth could not be unturned easily.
3. The detective was determined to unturn every stone in his pursuit of justice.
4. She believed that every secret, no matter how well hidden, would eventually be unturned.
5. No matter how hard they tried, the past could not be unturned or erased.
