

UNWARRANTABLE

Meaning: Unwarrantable: not justified or authorized; lacking adequate grounds or reasons.

1. His unwarrantable assumptions about her motivations led to a significant misunderstanding.
2. The committee deemed the charges against him to be unwarrantable and dismissed them outright.
3. She felt the criticism was unwarrantable, given her diligent efforts and commitment to the project.
4. In light of the evidence presented, the judge concluded that the search was unwarrantable and ruled it inadmissible.
5. The team's unwarrantable disregard for safety protocols put everyone at risk during the operation.
