2. His unwilling decision to leave the party early surprised everyone who knew him.
3. Despite their pleas, he remained unwilling to change his mind about the controversial project.
4. The unwilling acceptance of defeat left the team feeling disheartened and demotivated.
5. Her unwilling compliance with the new rules made it clear she was not on board with the changes.
