Meaning: Unwonder (verb): to diminish or eliminate a sense of wonder or amazement, often through familiarity or predictability.

1. The magician's tricks were so predictable that they unwondered the audience.
2. After years of travel, she found that the exotic locations no longer held their charm and had unwondered her sense of adventure.
3. The book's plot twists were so formulaic that they unwondered even the most devoted fans.
4. His constant complaints about the beauty of nature gradually unwondered her appreciation for the simple things.
5. As she grew older, the mysteries of life unwondered her youthful curiosity, leaving her with more questions than answers.
