

UP-TRAIN

Meaning: Up-train (noun): a train that is traveling towards a central or main station, typically in a direction of higher elevation or towards a designated terminal.

1. The up-train is scheduled to arrive at the station in fifteen minutes.
2. Passengers waiting for the up-train should ensure they have their tickets ready for inspection.
3. As the up-train pulled into the platform, the crowd surged forward in excitement.
4. The conductor announced that the up-train would make additional stops due to unforeseen delays.
5. Regular commuters prefer the early up-train to avoid the rush hour crowd later in the day.
