

# UPCOIL

*Meaning: **Upcoil**: (verb) To wind or roll up something, such as a cable or hose, in a neat and organized manner to prevent tangling or damage.*

1. The engineer decided to upcoil the cable to prevent tangling during transport.
2. After the storm, we had to upcoil the garden hose to ensure it wouldn't get damaged.
3. He carefully upcoiled the ropes after securing the boat to the dock.
4. To prepare for the hike, she began to upcoil the climbing gear and pack it away.
5. The technician instructed the team to upcoil the wires neatly before closing the panel.
