Meaning: Uproll (verb): to roll up or curl upward, often used to describe the action of bending or twisting something, such as a canvas or waves.

1. The artist decided to uproll the large canvas to create a unique display.
2. As the storm approached, the waves began to uproll violently against the shore.
3. He watched the kite uproll into the sky, dancing with the wind.
4. The children laughed as they attempted to uproll the heavy ball down the hill.
