Meaning: Upshoot (verb): to increase or rise sharply or suddenly, often in reference to prices or figures.

1. The stock prices began to upshoot following the announcement of the merger.
2. After years of steady growth, the company saw its sales upshoot dramatically this quarter.
3. Her enthusiasm for the project caused team morale to upshoot, leading to increased productivity.
4. The unexpected upshoot in tourist visits surprised local businesses, who were unprepared for the influx.
5. Due to the new marketing strategy, the number of subscribers began to upshoot significantly within weeks.
