2. In his speech, the mayor did not hesitate to urge the citizens to participate in the upcoming elections.
3. She decided to urge her friends to join her in the environmental clean-up initiative.
4. The teacher will urge her students to submit their projects before the deadline.
5. During the meeting, he made an effort to urge his colleagues to prioritize mental health in the workplace.
