

# USUFRUCTUARY

*Meaning: A usufructuary is a person who has the right to use and enjoy the benefits of property owned by another, typically while maintaining the property.*

1. The usufructuary enjoyed the right to harvest the crops from the land without owning it.
2. In legal terms, a usufructuary has the responsibility to maintain the property while benefiting from its use.
