Meaning: Vaporate: to change from a liquid into vapor, typically through the application of heat.

1. The scientist observed how the liquid would vaporate when heated to a certain temperature.
2. In the process of cooking, the water in the pot began to vaporate and fill the kitchen with steam.
3. To create a more pleasant atmosphere, the essential oils vaporate and disperse throughout the room.
4. As the sun rose, the morning dew began to vaporate, leaving the grass glistening in the light.
5. In a vacuum, substances can vaporate at lower temperatures than they would under normal atmospheric pressure.
