

# VAPORED

*Meaning: VAPORED (verb): the past tense of vaporize, meaning to convert a substance from a liquid or solid state into vapor, typically through the application of heat.*

1. The intense heat from the sun had completely vapored the morning dew from the grass.
2. In the lab, the scientist observed how the liquid vapored under high pressure, forming clouds of mist.
3. During the experiment, the solution vapored rapidly, leaving behind a residue of minerals.
4. As the temperature rose, the water in the pot slowly vapored, filling the kitchen with steam.
5. The artist used a technique where the paint was vapored onto the canvas for a unique texture.
