

VARICIFORM

Meaning: Variciform refers to a condition characterized by a swollen or twisted appearance, typically relating to veins or scar tissue resembling varicose veins.

1. The variciform veins in the patient's legs were a clear indication of chronic venous insufficiency.
2. Her variciform scar tissue from the surgery was a reminder of the long recovery she had endured.
3. The variciform patterns on the surface of the leaves added an unusual texture to the botanical illustration.
4. In art, variciform shapes can evoke a sense of movement and fluidity in a painting.
5. The geologist noted the variciform ridges on the landscape, attributing them to ancient volcanic activity.
