

# VELATE

*Meaning: To velate means to cover or overlay something with a thin, translucent layer, often to enhance or soften its appearance.*

1. The artist decided to velate the canvas with a thin layer of glaze to enhance the colors.
2. As the mist began to rise, it velated the landscape, creating an ethereal atmosphere.
3. She chose to velate the windows with sheer curtains, allowing soft light to filter through.
4. The photographer aimed to velate the edges of the image, giving it a dreamy, soft-focus effect.
5. In the final scene, the director instructed the lighting team to velate the stage for a more dramatic impact.
