

VENTRAD

Meaning: Ventrad: adverb describing a position toward the belly or front side of an organism.

1. The anatomy of the squid reveals that its heart is located ventrad to the gills.
2. In the study of vertebrate anatomy, the term ventrad is often used to describe positions relative to the belly.
3. During the surgical procedure, the incision was made ventrad to minimize damage to surrounding tissues.
4. In certain species of fish, the swim bladder is situated ventrad to the spinal column.
5. The anatomical diagram indicated that the liver is positioned ventrad of the diaphragm.

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
