

VERBALISM

Meaning: Verbalism refers to the use of words or language in a way that emphasizes expression or style over clarity or substance, potentially obscuring the true meaning.

1. Verbalism can often obscure the real meaning behind a speaker's intent.
2. The author's use of verbalism made the complex ideas more accessible to the audience.
3. In debates, excessive verbalism can distract from the core arguments being made.
4. Teachers sometimes discourage verbalism in favor of more concise and clear communication.
5. His tendency toward verbalism left listeners confused rather than enlightened.
