

VERNATE

Meaning: Vernate: to curl or fold in a way that protects new growth, especially in plants, during adverse weather conditions.

1. The leaves of the fern began to vernate as the warmer weather approached.
2. During spring, many plants will vernate their new growth to protect it from frost.
3. The botanist explained how some species vernate their leaves to conserve moisture.
4. As the season changed, the young shoots began to vernate under the early morning sun.
5. Observing the vernate patterns in the garden revealed the plants' adaptation to their environment.
