

# VERNISH

*Meaning: Varnish (verb): to apply a protective, glossy coating to a surface, typically wood or artwork, to enhance its appearance and durability.*

1. The artisan decided to varnish the wooden sculpture to enhance its natural color.
2. She carefully applied a coat of varnish to the canvas to protect her painting from dust.
3. The old furniture had lost its shine, so he planned to varnish it for a fresh look.
