

# VERSICLE

*Meaning: A versicle is a short sentence or phrase, often from scripture, recited by a leader during a religious service, typically followed by a response from the congregation.*

1. The priest recited a versicle as part of the evening service.
2. In the liturgy, a versicle often precedes the congregation's response.
3. The choir sang a beautiful melody that complemented the versicle beautifully.
4. Each versicle in the prayer book serves to enhance the spiritual experience.
5. During the ceremony, the officiant prompted the guests with a familiar versicle.
