

VESICULAR

Meaning: Vesicular refers to a structure or process involving small, membrane-bound sacs or vesicles that facilitate functions such as transport and gas exchange within biological cells.

1. The vesicular structure of the plant cells allows for efficient gas exchange.
2. During the experiment, we observed vesicular transport of proteins within the cell.
3. The vesicular lesions on the leaves indicated a viral infection in the crop.
4. In her presentation, she explained how vesicular neurotransmitters facilitate communication between neurons.
5. The vesicular bilayer of the virus makes it more resilient against environmental factors.
