

VESICULATION

Meaning: Vesiculation is the formation of small fluid-filled blisters or vesicles in tissues, often as a response to irritation or damage.

1. Vesiculation in the epidermis can indicate an allergic reaction to certain substances.
2. The research team observed vesiculation in the cell cultures after exposure to the toxic compound.
3. In botany, vesiculation refers to the formation of small blisters on plant surfaces, often due to disease.
