

VIGNETTER

Meaning: VIGNETTER (verb): To create a gradual transition to a softer edge or a blurred effect around the borders of an image or artwork, emphasizing the central subject.

1. The artist decided to vignette her latest painting to draw more attention to the central figure.
2. In the graphic design class, we learned how to vignette images for a more polished look.
3. To enhance the photo, she chose to vignette the edges, creating a soft focus effect.
4. The novel featured a vignette at the beginning of each chapter, setting the mood for the story.
5. As a filmmaker, he often used vignetting in his scenes to evoke a sense of nostalgia.
