Meaning: To vitriolize means to criticize or attack someone or something with harsh, bitter, or caustic language.

1. The critic did not hold back and chose to vitriolize the artist's latest work in her review.
2. During the debate, he seemed eager to vitriolize his opponent's arguments rather than focus on the issues at hand.
3. Social media platforms have become spaces where people often vitriolize public figures without considering the consequences.
4. Her choice to vitriolize the decisions of the committee only served to alienate her from potential allies.
5. In a moment of frustration, he began to vitriolize the entire team for their lack of effort in the project.
