Meaning: A voltmeter is an instrument used to measure the electrical potential difference, or voltage, between two points in a circuit.

1. The engineer used a voltmeter to measure the voltage across the circuit.

3. A digital voltmeter provides more accurate readings than an analog version.
4. In the classroom, the students learned how to connect a voltmeter to a battery.
