

VOLUNTARISM

Meaning: Voluntarism is the principle or doctrine that emphasizes the role of individual choice and free will in decision-making and action, particularly in social and philosophical contexts.

1. Voluntarism emphasizes the importance of individual choice and commitment in social movements.
2. In philosophical discussions, voluntarism is often contrasted with determinism, highlighting the role of free will.
3. The organization's success can be attributed largely to the spirit of voluntarism among its members.
4. Critics of voluntarism argue that it overlooks structural constraints that limit true choice.
5. In education, voluntarism can inspire students to engage more deeply with their learning through self-directed projects.
