

# WADDING

*Meaning: WADDING refers to a soft, thick material used for padding or insulation, often found in quilts or stuffed items.*

1. The wadding in the quilt provided an extra layer of warmth during the winter months.
2. She carefully stuffed the wadding into the toy to give it a plump and cuddly appearance.
3. After sewing the fabric together, he added wadding to create a soft cushion for the chair.
4. The artist used wadding to create a three-dimensional effect in her textile artwork.
5. During the crafting workshop, participants learned how to work with wadding to enhance their projects.
