

WAIVER

Meaning: A waiver is a legal document in which an individual voluntarily relinquishes a right or claim, often to acknowledge risks or liabilities associated with an activity.

1. The athlete signed a waiver to participate in the extreme sports competition.
2. Before entering the event, participants were required to submit a medical waiver.
3. The company offered a waiver on late fees for customers facing financial hardship.
4. She requested a waiver for the mandatory training session due to scheduling conflicts.
5. The legal team reviewed the waiver to ensure all liability concerns were addressed.
