

WASTEBOARD

Meaning: Wasteboard: a scrap or expendable piece of material used for testing tools or protecting surfaces during work.

1. The carpenter used a piece of wasteboard to test his new saw blade before working on the actual project.
2. In the workshop, the wasteboard served as a protective layer to prevent damage to the workbench.
3. After finishing the intricate cuts, she flipped her project over to reveal the wasteboard underneath, still intact.
