

WATERMARK

Meaning: A watermark is a recognizable image or pattern embedded in paper or digital content that indicates authenticity or ownership, often visible when viewed against light.

1. The artist included a subtle watermark on the bottom of the print to protect her work from being copied.
2. To ensure the authenticity of the document, the company added a watermark that could only be seen when held up to the light.
3. During the presentation, the speaker emphasized the importance of using a watermark to prevent unauthorized distribution of digital content.
4. When designing the new stationery, they decided to incorporate a custom watermark that reflected their brand identity.
5. The photographer was pleased to discover that her online portfolio now featured a discreet watermark on each image to deter theft.
