Meaning: WAVED: past tense of wave; to move one's hand or an object back and forth in greeting, farewell, or as a signal, or to move in a rising and falling manner, often in a flowing or undulating motion.

1. She waved goodbye to her friends as they drove away.
2. The flag waved gracefully in the gentle breeze.
3. He waved his hand to get the attention of the waiter.
4. The children waved excitedly when they saw the parade approaching.
5. After the meeting, she waved her hand dismissively, signaling the end of the discussion.
