

# WETHER

*Meaning: A wether is a male sheep that has been castrated, typically raised for meat production.*

1. The farmer decided to sell the wether along with the rest of his livestock.
2. A wether is often preferred for meat production due to its tender texture.
3. In the spring, the wether was released into the pasture to join the flock.
4. Many agricultural shows feature categories specifically for wethers in livestock competitions.
5. The shepherd explained that a wether is a castrated male sheep, typically more docile.
