

WHEREUPON

Meaning: 'Whereupon' is a conjunction meaning "following which" or "as a result of which," used to indicate a consequence or action that occurs immediately after a preceding event.

1. She asked him to explain his absence, whereupon he confessed to having lost track of time.
2. The team celebrated their victory, whereupon the coach delivered an inspiring speech.
3. He proposed a toast to their friendship, whereupon everyone raised their glasses in agreement.
4. The storm rolled in unexpectedly, whereupon the picnic was quickly moved indoors.
5. She found the missing keys under the couch, whereupon she breathed a sigh of relief.
