

WHIPT

Meaning: WHIPT (verb): the past tense of "whip," meaning to beat or stir a substance rapidly to incorporate air, or to move swiftly and sharply in a particular direction.

1. The chef expertly whipped the cream until it was light and fluffy.
2. She felt a rush of adrenaline as the roller coaster whipped around the bend.
3. He whipped the towel through the air, trying to get his friend's attention.
4. In a fit of excitement, the dog whipped around in circles, chasing its tail.
5. The storm clouds whipped through the sky, signaling an impending downpour.
