

WINDGALL

Meaning: Windgall is a swelling or fluid-filled sac that develops on the fetlocks of horses, often as a result of strain or injury.

1. A windgall can often be seen on the fetlocks of racehorses after intense training.
2. Veterinarians typically assess a windgall to determine if it's a sign of an underlying injury.
3. After the competition, the horse developed a small windgall that required monitoring.
4. Many horse owners seek remedies to alleviate the discomfort caused by a windgall.
5. The appearance of a windgall doesn't always indicate a serious problem, but it should still be evaluated.
