1. She withdrew from the competition after realizing she was not ready.
2. After much consideration, he withdrew his support for the project.
3. The company withdrew its advertisements following the controversy.
4. Feeling overwhelmed, she withdrew from social activities for a while.
5. He withdrew his hand from hers, unsure of his feelings.
6. The student withdrew from the class to focus on her mental health.
7. They withdrew the proposal after receiving negative feedback.
8. In a surprising move, the athlete withdrew from the tournament.
9. The funds were withdrawn from the account without prior notice.
10. As tensions rose, the diplomat withdrew from the negotiations.
