*Meaning: Withoutforth: adverb meaning to emerge or flow out freely and abundantly, often used to describe the spontaneous expression of feelings or ideas.*

3. The river surged forward, its waters glistening withoutforth any signs of pollution.
4. He spoke withoutforth any pretense, sharing his true thoughts and feelings.
5. The manuscript revealed ideas that emerged withoutforth the influence of established norms.
