Meaning: Woodenly: in a stiff, awkward, or unexpressive manner, lacking naturalness or emotional engagement.

1. He delivered his lines so woodenly that the audience struggled to connect with the character.

3. The actor's performance felt woodenly scripted, missing the emotional depth that the role required.
4. As he spoke, his gestures were woodenly exaggerated, drawing more attention to his awkwardness than his message.
5. She approached the task woodenly, following the instructions without any creativity or enthusiasm.
