*Meaning: Wronger: a comparative form of "wrong," indicating a greater degree of error or incorrectness in a specific context.*

1. Being late to the meeting was a mistake, but forgetting to prepare was wronger.
2. She thought she was being helpful, but her advice turned out to be wronger than she realized.
3. In this case, ignoring the warning signs was wronger than taking a risk.
4. It felt wronger to stay silent than to speak up against the injustice.
5. He soon discovered that his assumptions were wronger than he had initially thought.
