

WRUNG

Meaning: 'WRUNG' refers to the past tense of 'wring,' meaning to twist or squeeze something to remove liquid or to express anxiety or agitation through hand movements.

1. After the long hike, she wrung out her wet clothes before putting them on the line.
2. He wrung his hands nervously as he awaited the news.
3. The mechanic wrung the excess oil from the rag before setting it aside.
4. As she recounted the experience, tears wrung from her eyes, reflecting the pain she felt.
5. The farmer wrung the last drops of water from the soaked sponge to clean the tools.
