

XIPHISTERNUM

Meaning: XIPHISTERNUM: the small, cartilaginous structure at the lower end of the sternum that serves as an anatomical landmark in the human body.

1. The xiphisternum is a small but important anatomical landmark in the human body.
2. In some medical examinations, the xiphisternum is used as a reference point for measuring thoracic dimensions.
3. The xiphisternum, located at the lower end of the sternum, can sometimes cause discomfort during CPR.
4. During the dissection, the students were instructed to locate the xiphisternum to better understand the ribcage structure.
5. Anatomists often emphasize the significance of the xiphisternum in relation to surrounding organs and tissues.
