

ZUCHETTO

Meaning: A zucchetto is a small, skullcap worn by clergy, particularly by the pope and cardinals, during religious ceremonies.

1. The pope traditionally wears a zucchetto during liturgical ceremonies.
2. As a symbol of his office, the cardinal adjusted his zucchetto before addressing the crowd.
3. The zucchetto, a small skullcap, is often seen as a mark of humility in the Catholic Church.
4. During the conclave, each cardinal donned a white zucchetto to signify their role in the election process.
5. In artwork depicting clergy, the zucchetto is frequently highlighted as an important detail of their attire.
